- Finally, we love the adaptable and perennial Chocolate Lily with its scented violet-coloured flowers.

Inaugural Westbrook Community Fund Presentation Evening

In November, 19 happy community and not-for-profit groups from around the local neighbourhood received grants totalling \$18,500 at the inaugural Westbrook Community Fund presentation evening held at the Dennis Family Corporation's Westbrook estate in Truganina. Dennis Family Group Managing Director, Grant Dennis, was on hand to make presentations to the successful applicants and he couldn't have been more delighted with the outcome.

"The annual Community Fund concept was introduced in 2002 within our family business as a practical way of giving back to the communities we create," he explained. "Over the years, we've provided more \$600,000 in grants funding to many different organisations to across various residential estates in Victoria and South East Queensland to help make their projects possible." Mr. Dennis said Westbrook would become home to approximately 10,500 people over the next decade and that his family has always felt it is important to support the areas where its business operates.

"The establishment of the Westbrook Community Fund has enabled us to extend the reach of our support into the Truganina and Tarneit neighbourhoods where our Westbrook development is located. Eligibility for funding extended to not-for-profit groups operating in the Truganina and Tarneit area and it's fantastic that we have been able to support so many worthy organisations in the local neighbourhood."

An independent judging panel allocated grants of either \$500 or \$1,000 to the organisations which were successful in their application including The Bridge - Wyndham Community Benevolent Foundation, Truganina Fire Brigade, Victorian Bangladeshi Community Foundation and various local sporting clubs.



One organisation that was successful this time round was the Truganina Fire Brigade. Captain Mark Hatton was thrilled to accept a cheque for \$1,000 enabling them to acquire some new iPad tablets. "One of the biggest challenges we face at Truganina Fire Brigade are constantly evolving new roads and infrastructure. This money means we can now access the most up to date maps to determine the quickest routes to fire calls, and we can't thank the Dennis Family Corporation enough for helping us make
