CONSTRUCTION UPDATE


The New Year has now arrived, but the last 12 months have been huge for Westbrook.

GET READY FOR A NEW SCHOOL IN TOWN!



In just a few short years, Westbrook has transformed from grassy paddocks to a thriving community, with some fantastic new schools opening up just a short hop, skip and jump away from the estate.

But we're really excited to announce that a new school – Truganina North Secondary School (interim name), is set to open its doors in Term 1 of 2024 right in the very heart of Westbrook.

Putting a great education literally on the doorstep of the estate's growing number of families, the Junior Campus (years 7 – 9) will be located at 30 Everton Road and will be home to 600 junior students once the first stage of the school is complete. The new Senior Campus (years 10-12) just down the road at 805 Morris Road, will accommodate up to 800 students!

In its first year, Truganina North Secondary School (interim name) will open to Year 7 and Year 10 students only, and progress by year level after this.

The 2024 new school zones will be published online at <u>findmyschool</u>. <u>vic.gov.au</u> in Term 1, 2023. Enrolments for students in the local area are expected to open shortly after this, while the new school principal is expected to be appointed by Term 2, 2023.

IMPACTFUL REDS AND ORANGES

MARVELLOUS MAGENTA

With a vibrant spirit all of its own, Pantone has anointed Viva Magenta as its official colour of the year for 2023. A red with subtle notes of purple, magenta flawlessly complements many different colour palettes right across the spectrum from those on the richer, jewel-tone side to lighter, earthy shades.

UNEXPECTED GREENS

While more conventional mid-tone shades of green that mirror the colours of nature will remain popular, expect to see more unique citrusy and acidic versions like electric chartreuse and forest green on feature walls.

CRAFTY SHADES

Of course, it's not totally over for neutrals as nature continues to inspire colour trends. There's a growing interest in more earthbound natural shades linked to craft, especially shades of warm brown that are reminiscent of different types of woods, minerals, and even jewels. America's C2 Paint recently announced Tiramisu, a coppery, mid-tone brown, as its colour of the year which perfectly embodies this movement towards organic tones.

ALTERNATIVES TO BLACK

Black will never go out of style, but there's a plethora of other shades that can bring that sense of depth and elegance into a room.

Deep chocolates with notes of violet and black are a great alternative to black while other earthy violet tones are also rising in popularity. These deep shades of brown, purple, and green carry all the drama and strength of black, but feel more unexpected and layered.
